### Discussion Item 3: FY 2016 Project Ideas

- 1. **City Staff Time:** With the current number of projects City Forestry staff have to complete by the end of the fiscal year (June 30), they will not be able to take on additional Dean Fund Committee projects. Any additional projects that the Dean Fund would be interested in completing by June 30 will need to be contracted out.
- 2. **Citizen Pruner program**: Dean Fund Committee appropriated \$2,000 for the purchase of new tools, supplies and to support other Citizen Pruner activities.
- 3. **Dean Promenade on Main Street:** The Main Street Area Association has requested assistance in watering and fertilizing the beds in the Dean Promenade, approximate cost of \$5,000. The Dean Fund Committee requested that a representative from the Main Street Area Association attend an upcoming meeting to discuss project idea.
