Information item #1: FY 16 & FY17 Dean Fund Budget Reports & Project Status Updates

Provided a project update

- Vesper Project- Trees did not get planted, moved project to fall 2016. Tree Pruning \$5,337.51, went over budget for the pruning. There are still 4 crabapple trees that need to be planted at a cost of approximately \$1,300.
- **Triangle Neighborhood- Trees planted.** Planted 23 trees and ground several stumps in the neighborhood in early May. Charges for this project have not posted to the Dean Fund yet, it typically takes several weeks. Robert Bauman, the resident who applied to the Dean Fund Committee, handed out doorhangers to residents who received trees. The doorhanger included information about the Elizabeth Dean Fund information and tree care instructions.
- Scarlett Middle School Trees planted. Planted 2 trees for Arbor Day/Earth Day with students from Scarlett Middle School on April 29, 2016.
- **Citizen Pruner Program- Tool and supplies purchased.** The following tools and supplies were purchased: (10) Corona 7" Folding saws, (10) Barnel long handle saws, (20) Fiskar bypass pruners, (20) Pocket Diameter tapes, (5) Standard Diameter tapes, 5 Mesh bags for hard hat and vest storage.
- Watering Dean Promenade. Completed for June. Watering will continue through the summer.

Discussion Item #1: Project Ideas (FY17)

- Tree watering intern \$7,000/intern
 - Watering tank may need funding for a watering tank that could go in the bed of a truck. Staff will look into whether the city has a watering tank that can be used and an available truck for the intern.
- Main Street Honeylocust replacement and Ginkgo that died— approximate cost of \$1,500.
 - 2.5"-3" Honeylocust (need to remove the stump and all or most of the soil in the planting pit to eliminate the concern about any decay organisms that might be in the soil.
 - o 2.5"-3" Ginkgo
- Slauson Middle School Arbor Day/Earth Day tree planting event in spring.
- Dean Promenade- is there additional work that needs to be done?
