Information item #1: FY 17 Dean Fund Budget Reports & Project Status Update

- FY17- reviewed budget- funds spent to date have been on tree watering in the Dean Promenade
- Have Treasurer's office come to November meeting to discuss DFC Trust and other information.

Project Update:

- Vesper Project- Trees have been ordered for fall planting. 4 crabapple trees will be planted at a cost of approximately \$1,300.
- Watering Dean Promenade. Completed for July and August. Watering will continue through September.

Discussion Item #1: Continue Discussion on Project Ideas (FY17)

Apple donates iPads to educational institutions but not municipalities. Staff will continue to look into purchase options and will share with Dean Fund at a future meeting.

c) Tree Watering Temp.Staff still needs to identify if there is a vehicle to put a water tank on.

d) Areas with low canopy.

Members asked if there were areas of the city that had low tree canopy cover where the Committee could plant trees. Staff explained that the City conducted a urban tree canopy analysis in 2010 and have used the results of the analysis to help identify tree planting areas for the year. Many of the areas with low canopy cover have been planted over the last 6 years. Staff will look to see if there are additional opportunities to plant in these areas and bring suggestions to a future meeting.

- e) Landmark trees- are there special considerations or activities to be done to help trees in this category. This topic needs to be further explored by the Committee.
 - a. Staff will send a copy of the DRAFT Champion Tree List.
