AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE TO AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES BETWEEN

The Consultant shall be paid for Services under this Agreement at the fee set forth in Exhibit B for implementation, training/support, and annual hosting fees for the specified term of the Agreement, and in addition for implementation of the Staff Scheduler Module as identified in Exhibit A-1 Consultant shall be paid as set forth in Exhibit B-1 (which is attached hereto and made a part of this Amendment). Price includes charges for all Consultant personnel associated with the Project(s) and any other expenses the Consultant expects to incur in performance of Services. City to make payment within thirty (30) days after receipt of invoice for Services and approval by the Contract Administrator. It is understood and agreed between the parties that the compensation stated above is inclusive of any and all remuneration to which the Consultant may be entitled under this contract.

All terms, conditions, and provisions of the original agreement between the parties executed November 11, 2006, unless specifically amended above, are to apply to this amendment and are made a part of this amendment as though expressly rewritten, incorporated, and included herein.

This amendment to the agreement between the parties shall be binding on the heirs, successors and assigns of the parties.
