## CITY OF ANN ARBOR RENEWAL AGREEMENT CONSTRUCTION SERVICES

The City of Ann Arbor, a Michigan municipal corporation, located at 301 E. Huron St. Ann Arbor, MI 48104 ("City") and <u>Watertap, Inc.</u>, a Michigan Corporation located at 56720 McKenzie Lane. <u>South Lyon, Michigan 48178</u>, ("Contractor") entered into an agreement for the provision of <u>Water Main Line Stops and Insertion Valves, Bid No. ITB-4309</u> on <u>October 14</u>, 2013.

## Recitals:

Whereas, under the terms of the Agreement, the Agreement could be renewed upon proper notice and the mutual agreement of the parties for a period of <u>up to three (3) one year renewal periods</u>, and

Whereas, notice having been given and acknowledged and the parties having agreed to extend the Agreement for a period of <u>one</u> year(s) commencing <u>July 1, 2016</u>, and terminating June 30, 2017.

## Terms:

The parties agree as follows on this 15th day of June, 20/6

- Contractor shall provide <u>Water Main Line Stops and Insertion Valves</u> as specified in Bid No. <u>ITB-4309</u>.
- 2. Contractor shall maintain during the renewal agreement all required insurance endorsements under the original Agreement, dated <u>October 14, 2013</u>, and comply with all terms and conditions thereof, including but not limited to the provisions of Section 9:158 of Chapter 112 of Title IX of the Ann Arbor City Code and Living Wage requirements under Section 1:815 of Chapter 23 of Title I of the Ann Arbor City Code.
- City shall pay the Contractor the unit prices as given in the Bid Forms of the original agreement and approved contract change orders for an estimated total of <u>Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00)</u> per year for the services to be provided under this renewal agreement. Contractor to submit invoices as required under the original agreement. Payments subject to approval of the Contract Administrator.

All terms, conditions, and provisions of the original agreement between the parties executed October 14, 2013, unless specifically amended above, are to apply to this renewal and are made a part of this renewal as though expressly rewritten, incorporated, and included herein.

This renewal to the agreement between the parties shall be binding on the heirs, successors and assigns of the parties.
