
Executive Director, School & Student Safety

- Help facilitate and support "Safe Routes to School" plans and implementation at all 32 district schools.
- Serve as the AAPS representative with the City of Ann Arbor, Sheriff's Department, Pittsfield Township Public Safety and other community agencies to improve and ensure student safety.
- Oversee an education campaign to inform students, staff, parents and the community about student and school safety including pedestrian, transportation and traffic flow plans.
- Work with local law enforcement to schedule and train AAPS staff in the ALICE intruder response protocol.



- A safe school is a welcoming school.
- Our facilities should provide and our staff should communicate a sense of confidence and security to our students and parents.
- Engage all stakeholders staff, parents, students, law enforcement and the community
 which is key to creating healthy and happy learning environments.
- Be prepared. Plan, practice and implement protocols that offer assurances to our families and staff.
