It has been an honor to serve on the HRC during this particularly important time in its history alongside a group of people who are both thoughtful and passionate about protecting our citizens' civil rights. I'll add I have been inspired by your and the City Council's leadership concerning the community policing commission and appreciate the seriousness with which you and they have taken the issue. Thank you for giving me the opportunity to serve.
