#### IV. BUSINESS

1. FY 18 and FY19 Budget and Project Update Kerry Gray provided an update on projects funded in FY18 (July 1, 2017- June 30, 2018) and new projects in FY19 (July 1, 2018-June 30, 2019.

## 2. Discussion Item #1: FY19 Project Ideas

## a. Seventh Street Median (Stadium Blvd. to Scio Church)

**Mr. Wortman moved** to appropriate \$10,000 for the planting of 2" caliper street trees in the S Seventh St median between the south entry drive at Pioneer High School to Scio Church Road, with the mature size, species and location to be determined by city staff.

Sue Perry offered an amendment to the resolution - to appropriate \$10,000 for the planting of a *minimum* 2" caliper street trees *with a mature size greater than 50 feet tall* in the S Seventh St median between the south entry drive at Pioneer High School to Scio Church Road, with the mature size, species and location to be determined by city staff.

**Mr. Wortman accepted the amendment and moved** to appropriate \$10,000 for the planting of a minimum 2" caliper street trees with a mature size greater than 50 feet tall in the S Seventh St median between the south entry drive at Pioneer High School to Scio Church Road, with the mature size, species and location to be determined by city staff. **Ken Westerman seconded the motion.** Committee unanimously approved.

- b. Scio Church Median (West of Marra Dr to Greenview Dr) Committee discussed potential of project and asked staff to evaluate the area and provide recommendations on a potential project. This project will require input from the residents that live within the project area.
- c. **Dean Fund Plantings** Committee discussed ways the Dean Fund can work with other organizations to fund tree planting projects. Committee members offered to reach out to contacts within the community, including public schools, to see if they can develop some projects.
- d. **Champion/Landmark Trees –** committee would like to identify public trees that are Champion or Landmark status that may need tree care.
- e. 2222 Packard St. and Wurster Park Oak Mr. Wortman moved to approve \$460 for a trunk injection to improve the condition of the white oak street tree at 2222 Packard St. Ms. Perry seconded. Committee unanimously approved.

**Mr. Wortman moved to approve** \$693 for a trunk injection to continue treatment on the Wurster Park Black oak. **Mr. Westerman seconded.** Committee unanimously approved.

f. Tree Guards

**Ms. Perry moved to approrove** \$600 for the purchase to tree guards to protect newly planted street trees. **Mr. Wortman seconded.** Committee unanimously approved.

g. Fall 2018 – city staff street tree planting
Mr. Westerman moved to approve \$15,000 for fall 2018 city staff tree planting. Mr.
Wortman seconded. Committee unanimously approved.
