#### Comments::

This intersection has been a concern for our entire neighborhood especially as a number of residents have family and former neighbors living at Glacier Hills, so drivers and pedestrians often have to negotiate coming out of the neighborhood with commuters and emergency vehicles racing down Earhart. We also have 3 elementary schools within a mile of each other, all of which attract commuters from throughout the County and beyond given the Schools of Choice program as well the strong reputations of both private schools. Finally, we have a number of commuters in our neighborhood who work at the Toyota Tech Center, St. Joe's Hospital, Wayne State University, Ford Motor Company, and other metro-Detroit companies. They rely on this intersection and stretch to US23 to commute to outside of Ann Arbor on a daily basis. Being on the edge of Washtenaw County with easy access to US23 is one of the primary reasons for neighborhood residents to have bought homes here. Improvements similar to what we've already experienced and appreciate along Geddes would be most welcomed.

It is a dangerous intersection for drivers and pedestrians alike.

I am extremely disappointed that City Council is requiring City staff to host and engage public feedback for the entire road improvement process, beyond what we are accustomed to with past projects when we've been notified with postcards and occasional meetings after projects have been tested and approved. Will what was in the past, a fact-driven, science-based, results oriented process be undermined by the whims of City Council? What if public input ends up negatively impacting the safety of pedestrians, bikers, and drivers along this stretch because they've more effectively organized feedback? Given that this survey does not require contact information, how is one to weigh the considerations of near neighbors versus commuters? I find this survey and process to be unfortunate as I have yet to meet a single neighbor who wanted this additional "oversight." This is a waste of the City's resources. Staff expertise on routine projects should not be politicized.

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I am writing in strong support for bike lanes on all major roadways in Ann Arbor. Neighbors have mentioned that there is discussion about not including them when resurfacing Earhart. Is this correct?

I live in Ward 2 and use my bike to commute and run errands. I know many of my neighbors do the same. The Geddes/23 pedestrian bridge allows good access to the east but getting to it down Earhart is challenging at best.

Additionally I would like to know if there is any plan to build a pedestrian bridge on Earhart as it crosses 23. I believe a pedestrian bridge at this bottle neck (the shoulders are very narrow) would encourage bike commuting through this corridor. It would also be used by runners and walkers. I think this area is A2 township (I'm not sure) but would like to see A2 city take charge and make changes that would allow safer bike and pedestrian access.

Please let me know your thoughts.

I recently responded to the community survey regarding the Earhart Road Reconfiguration Project. I want to share additional comments – some of which I recognize may be out of the direct scope of this project, but are related.

I reside in a condo that I own at 812 Earhart Road, in the Earhart Village community. My home directly faces Earhart, so this project certainly affects my family and I. In addition to daily driving, I regularly walk in the neighborhood (on Earhart, Waldenwood, Penberton, and other nearby streets) and am accustomed to the general flow of people and vehicles. Also, I often work from home most of the time, so my perspective is based on what I see and experience at all hours of the day.

From what I see, traffic is heaviest on Earhart in the morning and evening rush hours, and around the end of the school day. Outside of those times, traffic seems considerably lighter.

I support the reduction of lanes from 4 to 2 in the sections between Waldenwood and Glazier.

I would also support the addition of street lights on Earhart. At night, the street is very dark, making it difficult to see when driving on the hills and inclines around Pine Brae and the cemetery.

I do not support the addition of roundabouts on Earhart. I support solutions that expedite vehicular traffic flow in a safe, reasonable manner. Roundabouts confuse drivers. I have to deal with the roundabouts on Geddes almost everyday. In doing so, I regularly encounter drivers who don't seem to understand how they work. Has the city considered a traffic light at Earhart and Glazier? Given the proximity to Greenhills School, King Elementary, and Glacier Hills, I sense that a traditional traffic light would be a safer alternative than roundabouts (or the pedestrian activated yellow lights, which I dislike)

so that it doesn't create more confusion for drivers and gives pedestrians an assured point to cross Earhart. What about a light on Earhart adjacent to St. Paul's? That driveway is a blind spot, and it's challenging when cars are turning in and out of the facility on school days.

Roundabouts won't increase the walkability of our neighborhood, and I'm concerned that they will only add traffic bottlenecks at the busiest times of the day.

I would welcome sidewalks on the east side of Earhart along the perimeter of my condo community (which I have voiced to my condo board). Currently, there are too many stretches of Earhart without sidewalks. I would welcome more sidewalks around the neighborhood in general, such as on the sections of Waldenwood that don't currently have them, as well as along Penberton and Greenhills. I'm a parent with a 4-year old. We take frequent walks. The lack of sidewalks is a major concern of mine.

As an aside, if the city really wanted to try a novel solution for minimizing traffic (or at least its impact on city residents), I would recommend considering a solution piloted in New Jersey, which limited certain streets to residents only during rush hour: <u>https://www.nytimes.com/2018/01/22/nyregion/leonia-gps-navigation-apps.html</u>.

I am a voter in Ward 2 and support the plan in progress for Earhart Rd.

I travel the Earhart Rd Section being discussed at Greenhills School on April 11, 2019, 3-7 pm.

I pass through this section to reach Washtenaw Community College for OLLI events, to watch soccer games at Concordia University and pick up soccer players from practice, to attend soccer games and practices at EMU Dome, to attend concerts and plays at Concordia University, to reach St. Joe's Hospital, to reach Depot Town, Farmer's Market and other points of interest in Ypsilanti.

The road is very narrow between the Botsford Cemetery and the Lutheran Elementary School on the top of the hill. It is very dark from Pine Brae to Glazier Way and I have a hard time seeing walkers and bike riders near sunset. The potholes make it necessary for me to swerve and weave my way through. I see the plan stretches from 2019 to 2021.

Actually, I believe the project needs to be sped up and needs to include sidewalks on both sides of Earhart Rd. all the way from the roundabout at Geddes Rd north to US 23, street lights, bike lanes, right turn lanes at Lutheran Elementary School, Waldenwoods (heading South), Glacier Hills (heading North), Greenhills School (heading North) Glazier Way (heading South), and Riping Dr.(heading South) and the extra lane(s) are removed. Let's go forward sooner rather than later.

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Thank you for your interest in improving the safety of Earhart road. Unfortunately, I am not able to make the meeting this evening. However, as a resident of a nearby neighborhood and as a parent of a preschooler who attends St. Paul Lutheran School, I have two opinions to share that will hopefully be helpful to consider.

First, the road as it passes St. Paul Lutheran School is narrow and cars routinely speed down that stretch. It can be harrowing to turn left out of St. Paul with the oncoming traffic. It is my opinion that a slower speed limit is appropriate there, with additional signage indicating a school zone. Also, police could consider monitoring for speeders through that area. It is a safety issue for the attendees of St. Paul's, many of which are preschool age.

Second, the condition of Earhart road is terrible, as I'm sure you're aware. Particularly, the southbound section near Kipling Drive is not drivable at anywhere close to the posted speed limit due to multiple contiguous potholes and their associated patchwork of patches. I am concerned when I read these plans that real improvement to the road is not planned for several years. Something more than just individual pothole filling needs to be done to replace the crumbling portions of the road before that time.

Regarding the discussion of Earhart Road Safety Improvements, repaving is a must and the idea of roundabouts to reduce speeding is reasonable. However, the reduction of 4 lanes to 2 and inclusion of bike lanes is ridiculous. You have traffic data for Earhart - 7246 vehicles per day and 1046 in the peak hour. What is the traffic data for bikes? Does it justify removing 2 lanes of traffic? I doubt you have any data, and it is inconceivable that it justifies the proposed change. I have lived off of Earhart for almost 30 years and I look out onto the road several hours a day as the window I work at faces the street. I can attest that bicycle traffic - even in the best of weather - is maybe a few per day. 6 months of the year there is none. And if there are bikers on Earhart, how are they supposed to get there or leave? The bridge over US-23 narrows to 2 lanes that doesn't allow for either bikes or pedestrians. And there are no bike lanes on Geddes. As presented, this is a poorly thought-out plan and a waste of taxpayer money and I strongly object to it.

It is well known among Ann Arbor residents that this bike lane policy has caused major problems on roads where it was implemented, such as Maple Rd. Further, I'm sure the city has historical data on traffic on major roads in Ann Arbor that shows that the volumes are increasing, not decreasing, similar to US-23 and I-94. So how can such a policy be justified. I would like to know what is the justification for conversion of streets in Ann Arbor from 4 lanes of traffic to 2 with the others occupied by bike lanes that are rarely used. Who is pushing this bad idea and why?

In 15 years of living in Earhart Village I have only once seen a biker heading toward Concordia.

I believe that any time or money spent on planning a bike path is wasteful since it would rarely be used.

The hill is too steep to climb on a bike and too steep to ride down safely and under control.

Please study this observation before planning a bike trail.

I recently responded to the community survey regarding the Earhart Road Reconfiguration Project. I want to share additional comments – some of which I recognize may be out of the direct scope of this project, but are related.

I reside in a condo that I own at 812 Earhart Road, in the Earhart Village community. My home directly faces Earhart, so this project certainly affects my family and I. In addition to daily driving, I regularly walk in the neighborhood (on Earhart, Waldenwood, Penberton, and other nearby streets) and am accustomed to the general flow of people and vehicles. Also, I often work from home most of the time, so my perspective is based on what I see and experience at all hours of the day.

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As an aside, if the city really wanted to try a novel solution for minimizing traffic (or at least its impact on city residents), I would recommend considering a solution piloted in New Jersey, which limited certain streets to residents only during rush hour: <u>https://www.nytimes.com/2018/01/22/nyregion/</u>leonia-gps-navigation-apps.html.

I attended public meeting on the Earhart Road project held a few weeks ago at Greenhills School and finally have time to provide my thoughts. I have two sets of concerns:

1. I find it difficult to believe that there is enough roadway width between St. Paul School and the cemetery to actually add a bike lane in each direction. At the public meeting, none (!) of the City staff knew how wide the road was at that location. Having travelled along that section of Earhart since 1972, just looking at the area, it does not appear there is space to add the bike lanes without cutting down trees in front of the school or cemetery.

2. More importantly, I was strongly opposed to the concept of establishing an "island" with paint and delineators on Waldenwood just west of the intersection with Earhart. Please see the Intersection Blowup image on the City website named "Earhart/Waldenwood blown up image." The area of concern is shown in the yellow highlight. I have lived in the third cul de sac to the west of this intersection since 2005, so have used this intersection over 11 thousand times (at a very rough minimal estimate)!

• There is no reason to create an "island" on Waldenwood! While the road may seem wide, no one uses it as three lanes. If there is a concern, a simple painted strip should minimize an confusion for the cars once the "circle" in the middle of the Earhart-Waldenwood-Greenhills intersection is created.

• Just west of the tree shown on the south side of Waldenwood is a taxi stand. If the road is narrowed from the island, there will be interference with the taxis who do park there.

• In that same area on the north side, just before the first cul de sac, City school buses park and wait for the end of classes at King School. Once again, if the road is narrowed from the island, there will be interference with those parked buses.

• When there are events at King School, cars park along the south side of Waldenwood, often all the way to Earhart. Once again, if the road is narrowed from the island, there will be interference with those parked cars.

• I am concerned about snow plowing if the City installs delineators! The City has enough difficulty in plowing the streets in my neighborhood right now and if those are installed, then the plows will have more difficulty in keeping that area clear.

• Installing delineators will make it more difficult for not only the City school buses to make the turns onto Waldenwood but all of the delivery trucks that use the road.

• Installing delineators will require drilling into the asphalt and will simply create more damage to the roadway from the winter freeze-thaw cycle. I am VERY strongly opposed to the installation on Waldenwood. This is simply overkill, will create a variety of problems, is not necessary, and simply painting the roadway would be a simpler and effective solution.

• The creation of the circles in the intersection will create the proper use of the road. There are other circles in the city where delineators have not been installed on the approaching intersections and this has not created a problem.

• I am also opposed to installation of delineators in the circles " in the middle of the Earhart-Waldenwood-Greenhills and the Glazier Way-Earhart intersections due to he damage that will be created overtime to the roadway. But I suspect this is something that cannot be changed.

In summary, please consider modifying the plan to eliminate the use to delineators on Waldenwood. This is simply overkill, will create a variety of problems, is not necessary, and simply painting the roadway would be a simpler and effective solution.
