The Washtenaw County Office of Community and Economic Development (OCED), has an extraordinary opportunity that may benefit your local residents tremendously. The Weatherization Assistance Program is a free residential energy conservation program that provides financial savings to low-income Michigan homeowners and renters. These services can reduce home energy use by roughly 30%, lower utility bills, and increase safety, comfort, and savings for your jurisdiction's residents.

Through our weatherization program, we are able to:

- Perform a comprehensive energy audit to assess the energy efficiency of a home
- Repair or replace inefficient furnaces and water heaters
- Replace old refrigerators with new energy star rated units
- Air seal and insulate walls, attics, and foundation spaces
- Install energy efficient light bulbs and fresh air fan systems

Any resident of Washtenaw County who has an income at or below 200% of the federal poverty level may qualify for our program. We are asking our cities and townships to refer residents to us. Our program is open to both homeowners and renters, although renters have to meet additional requirements (apartments are not eligible).

- Replace old refrigerators with brand new, energy efficient refrigerators
- Air seal and insulate walls, attics, and crawl spaces
- Install energy efficient light bulbs and fresh air fan systems

All work is overseen and inspected by Washtenaw County employees.
