# AMENDMENT NUMBER 1 TO AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES BETWEEN TETRA TECH, INC. AND

### THE CITY OF ANN ARBOR FOR 2018 ANN ARBOR LANDFILL MONITORING AND MAINTENANCE PROGRAM

The City of Ann Arbor, a Michigan municipal corporation, having its offices at 301 E. Huron St. Ann Arbor, Michigan 48104 ("City"), and <u>Tetra Tech Inc.</u> ("Contractor") with its address at <u>710 Avis Drive</u>, <u>Suite 100</u>, Ann Arbor, MI 48108 agree to amend the professional services agreement for the project <u>2018 Ann Arbor Landfill Monitoring and Maintenance Program</u> executed by the parties dated <u>5th day of July</u>, <u>2017</u> ("Agreement") as follows:
