BACKGROUND

- Two millages proposed
 - Street, Bridge, and Sidewalk Millage
 - New Sidewalk Millage (for filling gaps in the sidewalk system)
- November 2020 ballot (due to lack of an election in 2021)
- Council resolution directing staff to prepare ballot language and seeking options for the New Sidewalk Millage (June 1, 2020)

STREET, BRIDGE, & SIDEWALK MILLAGE

<u>What is being proposed:</u>

- 2.125 mils (\$13.8M/yr) same as previous millage
- 5 year millage starting in 2022 What it can be used for:
- Resurfacing, reconstruction, and capital maintenance of streets and bridges
- Crosswalks & sidewalk ramps
- Sidewalk repairs
- Non-assessable portions of sidewalk gap projects

NEW SIDEWALK MILLAGE

What is being proposed:

- 0.20 mils (\$1.3M/yr)
- 6-year millage starting 2021
- Would fully or partially replace special assessments
- Apply to taxable parcels only
- Would not replace developer obligations



NEW SIDEWALK MILLAGE

Primary decision points:

- Partially or fully replace special assessments?
- Should the millage be retroactive to cover
 previously approved
 assessments?



NEXT STEPS

- Early July Memo to Council regarding millage options
- July 20 Resolutions to Council (Ballot Language & Detailed Use)
- August 11 Deadline to submit final ballot language
- August thru October Communications Phase
- November 3 Election Day
