#### **PROJECT UPDATES**

#### 1. Vet's Park potential Soldier Row

Trees are planted! All trees were planted. Hillary requested 3 trees be replaced due to not meeting our minimum specifications. Get out and take a look!

#### **POTENTIAL PROJECTS**

#### 1. Ferdon Rd and Granger Ave.

A letter was sent to residents that would potentially receive trees. I have not received any communication back from those residents.

#### **Project Costs:**

\$175.00/2-inch caliper tree (does not include delivery/installation): \$1,225.00 Estimated installation fee: \$250.00/tree: \$1,750.00

Watering for one season would be an estimated additional \$100/watering. 12 waterings: \$1,200.0

#### **Total potential cost calculations:**

7 trees x (\$175.00 + \$250.00)/tree = \$2,975.00 + \$1,200.00 (watering) = \$4,175.00
