

**AMENDMENT NUMBER 1
TO
PERSONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT
BETWEEN CITY OF ANN ARBOR AND JULIE ROTH**

This Amendment Number 1 (“Amendment”) is to the agreement between the City of Ann Arbor, (“City”) and Julie Roth (“Contractor”) for personal services related to creating, piloting and scaling the Ann Arbor Solarize program which is dated June 29, 2020 (“Agreement”). City and Contractor agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

- 1) Article 4 relating to Contractor’s compensation, is amended to read as follows:

Contractor shall receive as compensation for the covenants to be observed and services to be performed as set forth above, \$50.00 per hour for services accepted by the City as meeting the standards under the contract. Subject to prior approval, Contractor will be reimbursed for reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in connection with this contract. It is understood and agreed between the parties that the compensation stated above is inclusive of any and all remuneration to which the Contractor may be entitled. The total compensation under this contract shall not exceed \$50,000.

- 2) Article 5 relating to the term and duration of the Agreement, is amended to read as follows:

This agreement shall be in effect from May 4, 2020 to June 30, 2021, unless terminated earlier under Paragraph 6 or extended by mutual agreement in writing.

All terms, conditions, and provisions of the Agreement, unless specifically amended above, shall apply to this Amendment and are made a part of this Amendment as though expressly rewritten, incorporated, and included herein.

City and Contractor agree that for this Amendment and any documents related to the Agreement: 1) signatures may be delivered electronically in lieu of an original signature; 2) to treat electronic signatures as original signatures that bind them; and 3) signatures may be executed and delivered by facsimile and upon such delivery, the facsimile signature will be deemed to have the same effect as if the original signature had been delivered to the other party.

This Amendment to the Agreement shall be binding on the Parties’ heirs, successors, and assigns.
