The alleged practical difficulties are exceptional and peculiar result from conditions that do not exist generally throughout					
Based on several other self-storage buildings constructed by the developer the parking required per UDC greatly exceeds the actual demand. The proposed building floor areas result in significantly less FAR than what is allowable, yet there is not enough site area to provide the required amount of parking. The property is zoned C2B and bordered on the north, east, and south by residential zoning causing significant loss in buildable area due to conflicting land use buffers.					
The alleged practical difficulties that will result from a failure to grant the variance, include substantially more than mere inconvenience, inability to attain a higher financial return, or both. Requiring the amount of parking per UDC would result in a large amount of parking spaces that would not be utilized					
and would result in an inefficient use of the property.
