

Jon,

We look at the impact a new driveway would have on existing and planned infrastructure along with sight distance into and out of the driveway.

We are not supportive of driveways located so closely to intersections if there is an alternative. However, my biggest concern is the proposed driveway's location in relation to the ROW line and eventual sidewalk placement.

It is difficult to tell without the dimension on the drawing, but the driveway appears to be less than one foot off the ROW. This would be very undesirable when the sidewalk eventually comes through. I do not have grading, but it looks like it would be difficult to design this circular driveway to accommodate the sidewalk.



If the ZBA is inclined to allow the new driveway, I would like to see the homeowner install the sidewalk on their frontage as part of the project to ensure that the new driveway would not create problems for the public sidewalk. (I do understand that it would be quite a while before we get to this gap, but I think we can expect the driveway to be in place for at least 50 years.)

The distance between the front door and the curb is only 50'. It may be easiest for the homeowner to provide a pedestrian route from the street to their front door instead of vehicular access.
