

Social Distancing Plan for 2021 Take Back the Night Ann Arbor

- 1) All guidelines laid out by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services will be followed to the best of our ability.
- 2) The rally itself will be held outdoors on the Diag of the University of Michigan, working with the parameters of the university restrictions at the time. A tent will be set up for inclement weather.
- 3) Volunteers will be tested prior to the event and not allowed to attend in person if they do not have a negative test.
- 4) Social distancing captains will be assigned to keep people 6 feet apart and masks will be required.
- 5) Masks will be available at the event for people who do not bring them as well as hand sanitizing stations.
- 6) During the march, social distancing captains again will be responsible to keep the group spread out and that masks are worn.
- 7) To encourage people to be involved in event who are unable to attend in person due to safety reasons, entire rally/march will be live streamed. If it is not feasible to hold the event in person even outdoors, event will be held virtually.
- 8) There will also be an option for people to march in smaller local groups and join us via Zoom. This is to help keep crowd size down.
