NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
2511 NEWPORT ROAD REZONING
(2511 NEWPORT ROAD)

The Ann Arbor City Council will conduct a public hearing at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, April 5, 2021 to hear all those interested in the proposed Ordinance No. ORD-21-04 – 2511 Newport Road Rezoning. This ordinance would rezone 1.55 Acres from TWP (Township District) to R1A (Single-Family Dwelling District), at 2511 Newport Road.

The proposal would amend the City Zoning Map, which is a part of Section 5:10.2 of Chapter 55, Title V of the Ann Arbor City Code.

Section 1. THE ZONING MAP, which, by Section 5.10.2 of Chapter 55 (Unified Development Code) of the City of Ann Arbor is made a part of said Unified Development Code, shall be so amended as to designate the zoning classification of property described as follows:
