

Approved Resolution of Housing and Human Services Advisory Board on May 13, 2021 pertaining to the proposed changes include allowing ADUs in more zoning districts and relaxing the standards in zoning districts where ADUs are currently allowed.

The following resolution was moved by Eleanor Pollack (Support: Ella Hall) and passed unanimously:

Whereas ADUs present a promising opportunity for creating housing for many community members including young professionals and seniors, and

Whereas HHSAB supports the proposed changes to the zoning for Accessory Dwelling Units as it reduces barriers for homeowners who would like to add an ADU and expands the number of locations on which ADUs can be built. Now, therefore, be it:
