In 1964, Elizabeth R. Dean bequeathed \$2 million to the City of Ann Arbor *"to be held in trust in perpetuity, to repair, maintain and plant trees on city property."* The trust is managed by the Elizabeth Dean Fund Committee which accepts proposals for special tree planting and maintenance projects to enhance Ann Arbor's urban and community forest.

- Neighborhood parks
- Historic neighborhoods
- Public Housing Sites
- Community Centers
