Report given by Commission members on outcome of Public Meeting on January 15. Motion made by B. Galardi and seconded by A. Jackson to amend the Resolution to approve Option 1A.

C. Smith read the Resolution:

RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE RECONSTRUCTION AND RELOCATION OF TENNIS COURTS IN WINDEMERE PARK

Whereas, the tennis courts in Windemere Park are in need of replacement;

Whereas, the tennis courts are a heavily utilized neighborhood asset;

Whereas, the tennis courts are in an underserved Northeast area of the City;

Whereas, saturated organic soils and a high water table have resulted in an unstable base and heaving of the existing net posts;

Whereas, a number of potential locations exist for replacing the tennis courts in areas where soil borings indicate acceptable conditions for a tennis court;

Whereas, the Park Advisory Commission (PAC) values the input of the neighbors and community in making a decision regarding the tennis courts;

Whereas, PAC has previously supported by resolution that the tennis courts in Windemere Park be replaced;

Whereas, PAC has previously supported by resolution that this reconstruction be accomplished for no more than 10-20% above normal reconstruction costs;

Whereas, input from neighbors and the community has been solicited through two initial public meetings, written communication, and public commentary at PAC meetings;

Whereas, PAC has previously supported by resolution the recommended placement of the reconstructed tennis courts in accordance with Option 4 at their October 23, 2012 meeting;

Whereas, community members requested that PAC reconsider the selection of location 4 to replace the tennis courts at the PAC November 19, 2013 meeting;

Whereas, input from neighbors and the community has been solicited through one additional public meeting on January 15, 2014, written communications and an Ann Arbor Open City Hall survey specific to this topic; RESOLVED, that PAC revisits the Option 4 recommendation incorporating and considering input solicited and received from neighbors and the community regarding site location;

RESOLVED, that PAC recommend site 1A as the location for reconstructing the tennis courts in Windemere Park; and

RESOLVED, that the PAC recommends staff prepare bids for construction of the Windemere Tennis Courts in the location recommended by the Park Advisory Commission meeting on January 28, 2014.

C. Smith read the Resolution:

RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES GRANTS MANAGEMENT FOR A UNIVERSAL ACCESS PLAYGROUND AT GALLUP PARK

Whereas, The City park system does not have a Universal Access Playground;

Whereas, The Park and Recreation Open Space Plan identifies an area of focus as providing play areas that are designed to allow disabled users greater opportunities;

Whereas, The playground at Gallup Park is in need of replacement;

Whereas, The Rotary Club of Ann Arbor has committed \$250,000.00 toward a Universal Access Playground in celebration of their upcoming centennial year in 2016; and

Whereas, Grants are available through the Michigan Department of Natural Resources Grants Management to assist in funding improvements such as this project;

RESOLVED, That City Council directs the City Administrator to apply to the Michigan Department of Natural Resources Grants Management for a Universal Access Playground at Gallup Park and authorizes the City Administrator to execute all documents required for or incidental to the application process.

C. Smith reported on high level of activity at the livery and the need for additional vehicles for shuttling people from Gallup back to the Livery.

C. Smith read the Resolution:

RESOLUTION TO RECOMMEND APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF TWO 15 PASSENGER VANS FROM RED HOLMAN GMC (STATE OF MICHIGAN BID, 50,212.00)

Whereas, The Canoe Livery experienced a 22% growth in rental from fiscal year 2012 to 2013 which requires additional vans to shuttle customers to decrease prolonged wait times for customers;

Whereas, The Canoe Livery is not proposing to increase its fleet of boats and the additional vans are to improve day to day operations to better accommodate for the current demand;

Whereas, Red Holman GMC, Westland MI, is the lowest responsive bidder to the State of Michigan's and Oakland County's Cooperative Bid program; and

RESOLVED, That the Parks Advisory Commission recommend approval for the issuance of a purchase order to Red Holman GMC for the purchase of two 2014 GMC Savana 15 passenger vans at \$25,106.00 each for a total amount of \$50,212.00; and

RESOLVED, That funds for this purchase come from the FY 2014 approved Parks & Recreation Services General Fund budget with funds to be available without regard to fiscal year.
