Trespass Update

Trespass Status of Discussion: L. Stambaugh reported the working group (including AAPD Deputy Chief Metzger and Deputy City Attorney Arianne Slay) will meet at the end of August. They will discuss revising the Trespass Notice to make the form more user friendly, provide property owners and agents options for how long the trespass notice will remain in effect, and clarify the appeals process.
