4/5/2010 1 City Council Resolution to Approve Ann Arbor Public Art Commission Bylaws and Guidelines In November of 2007, City Council adopted an ordinance establishing a Percent for Art Program. With the adoption of the Public Art Ordinance, City Council established the Ann Arbor Public Art Commission (AAPAC) as the oversight body for the Percent for Art Ordinance.

Attached are the recommended Ann Arbor Public Art Commission Bylaws and Guidelines for City Council review and approval.
