Resolution to Approve Amended Bylaws of the Public Market Advisory Commission
The Public Market Advisory Commission (PMAC) recommends approval of the attached amended bylaws. The bylaws have been revised with the assistance from the City Attorney’s office. With these revisions, PMAC bylaws will be consistent with the format for other City Commissions’ bylaws, eliminate references that are no longer applicable, and have improved structure and clarity. The revised bylaws were unanimously approved by PMAC at its meeting of September 19, 2013. Attached also is an overview of the amendments. The changes have been reviewed by the City Attorney’s Office, consistent with Council Resolution R-08-496.
