**PROCLAMATION**  
*Huron River Day*  
*July 17, 2011*

*WHEREAS, The Huron River is a major environmental asset of the Ann Arbor community; and*

*WHEREAS, All residents of the Ann Arbor area should know how important the river is to our community and how it is the responsibility of each of us, individually and jointly, to actively participate in its care and protection; and*

*WHEREAS, This is Ann Arbor’s 31st<sup>h</sup> celebration of Huron River Day; and the first to be joined by parks throughout the length of the river; and*

*WHEREAS, This is a day for residents of the Ann Arbor Community to enjoy being on the river and its shores with games, exhibits, walks, canoes and paddle boats and to learn more about its care.*
