Whereas, Ann Arbor Senior Living Owner, LLC is the owner of property commonly known as 2840 South Main Street, as described in Liber 5241, Page 248 of Deeds, Washtenaw County Records; and

Whereas, Ann Arbor Senior Living Owner, LLC has signed a grant of easement for water mains and appurtenances, described as:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot 2 of "South Main Woods" Subdivision, recorded in Liber 10 of Plats, Page 1, being part of Section 5, Town 3 South, Range 6 East, City of Ann Arbor, Washtenaw County, Michigan; thence S85°44'47"W 447.85 feet; thence N04°15'13"W 40.00 feet; thence N85°44'47"E 237.40 feet; thence S49° 15'13"E 35.36 feet; thence N85°44'47"E 186.22 feet; thence S01°16'20"E 15.00 feet along the Westerly Right of Way line of S. Main Street to the Place of Beginning.
