Resolution to Approve Elizabeth Dean Fund Street Tree Planting Projects for 2009 and to Appropriate Funds (\$32,000.00) (8 Votes Required)

At their December 4, 2008, meeting, the Elizabeth Dean Fund committee identified and approved street tree planting projects totaling \$32,000.00 to be spent in accordance with the purpose of the Elizabeth Dean Trust Fund for fiscal year 2009. The trees will be planted along Packard Road, Plymouth Road and Eisenhower Parkway in the spring of 2009 by City staff. The City of Ann Arbor and Elizabeth Dean Fund committee are requesting that City Council appropriate fund balance from the Elizabeth Dean Trust Fund in the amount of \$32,000.00 and establish an expenditure budget in this fund without regard to fiscal year.

Whereas, The Elizabeth Dean Fund Committee has identified street tree planting projects for FY 2009; and
