Resolution Authorizing Summary Publication of Ordinance No. ORD-10-08 to Repeal Sections 10:161 and 10:163 and to Amend Section 10:162, Chapter 127, Title X (Bicycle Registration) of the Code of the City of Ann Arbor.

The attached resolution authorizes the summary publication of Ordinance No. ORD-10-08 to Repeal Sections 1:161 and 1:163 and Amend Section 1:162 of Chapter 126 (Bicycle Registration) of Title X of The Code of the City of Ann Arbor. Ordinance No. ORD-10-08 amends Chapter 126 to repeal the bicycle registration requirements.

The City Charter contains provisions to allow summary publications of ordinances that are in excess of 500 words in length. The purpose of this resolution is to lessen the City’s cost resulting from the required publication of the revisions to the City Code.

Ordinance No. ORD-10-08 amends Chapter 126 to repeal the bicycle registration requirements and to eliminate the obligation of the City Clerk to retain bicycle registration records created before the repeal.
