Title: DR23-0004; 228 Packard Street
 The proposed apartment building, featuring ground-floor commercial space and a parking structure, occupies a block bordered by Packard Street, South Fifth Avenue, East Madison Street, and South Fourth Avenue. Its design transitions from six stories on Packard to 12 on Madison, reflecting the block's slope. The minimalist, naturally-colored building has a one-story base on the north and a three-story base on the south, with distinct overhangs and material changes.
