Whereas, The Council Liquor License Review Committee has completed its annual review of on-premises liquor licenses in accordance with Section 9:79 of the Ann Arbor City Code;

Whereas, After investigation and receipt of recommendation from City service areas, the Council Liquor License Review Committee recommends non-renewal of the on-premises liquor licenses for the following license holders:

- Liquor License No. 186555-2011 held by V.R. Entertainment Network, Inc. (d/b/a Dream Niteclub & Lounge) for violations of Chapter 109 including violations of the state liquor law and the maintenance of a nuisance upon or in connection with the licensed premises; and
- Liquor License No. 199326-2011 held by RUSH 314 LLC for failure to timely pay all taxes due and owing to the City.

Whereas, City Council has previously appointed a Hearing Officer to conduct the required hearing on a recommendation of non-renewal and the Council Liquor License Review Committee has set the date of March 19, 2012 for hearing the above matters;

RESOLVED, That City Council accept the recommendation that the above matter be set for hearing for the reasons stated and all other on-premises liquor licenses be renewed for this annual renewal period.
