Whereas, The City of Ann Arbor and City of Ypsilanti, both located in Washtenaw County, Michigan, created a Local Development Financing Authority (LDFA) for the Ann Arbor/Ypsilanti SmartZoneSM ;

Whereas, The agreement between the two cities requires the City Council of the City of Ann Arbor to appoint six voting members to the governing body of the LDFA; and

Whereas, There is currently one full term position available on the LDFA Board;

RESOLVED, That Ned Staebler be appointed to fill a full four-year term through June 30, 2015;
