An Ordinance to Amend Sections 7:360, 7:361 and 7:362 and to Amend by Adding New Sections Which Sections Shall Be Designated as 7:363, 7:364 and 7:365 of Chapter 91 (Endangered Species) of Title VII (Businesses and Trades) of the Code of the City of Ann Arbor (ORD-21-26)

This ordinance renames Chapter 91 from “Endangered Species” to “Sale of Animal Products” and adds a provision that bans the sale of fur products in the City of Ann Arbor.
