Resolution to Appropriate Funding for GovOS Short Term Rental Software (\$49,900.00) (8 Votes Required)

Rental Housing Services has contracted with GovOS to track short-term rental properties in the community that are actively operating to ensure they are properly licensed and regulated per Chapter 97.

This resolution requests funding to cover the cost of delivery, implementation, and training hours.

March 2024 marks the second year that Chapter 97 has been in effect; this software will help to redefine the ordinance, identify gaps in enforcement, and properly communicate expectations in the community.

Budget/Fiscal Impact: The Building and Rental Service Manager is requesting a budget appropriation to the FY24 budget for the Building and Rental Services General Fund expenditure budget in the amount of \$49,900.00. This appropriation request will cover all the anticipated costs for delivery, implementation, and staff training of the GovOS short-term rental software.
