Whereas, The City Council had directed the City Assessor to prepare a Special Assessment Roll for the purpose of defraying that part of the cost of the following described public improvement to be defrayed by Special Assessment: Construction of a new sidewalk along the west side of Stone School Road from Birch Hollow Drive to Packard Road; Stone School Sidewalk Special Assessment District No. 47, File No. 2015-033;
