Resolution to Approve the Loo Annexation, 0.51 Acres, 444 Huntington Place (CPC Recommendation: Approval - 8 Yeas and 0 Nays)

Approval of this resolution will allow annexation of this property from Ann Arbor Township into the City. The property is within the City's water and sewer service area, and the current use is consistent with the adjacent zoning, land uses and master plan. Council action on the proposed R1B (Single-Family District) zoning will be scheduled after the annexation process is complete.

The City Planning Commission, at its meeting of April 16, 2024 recommended approval of the request.
