WHEREAS, the President shall carry out the other duties assigned in these By-Laws; and

**WHEREAS**, The Vice-President shall perform the duties of the President in the absence or incapacity of the President. In the case of the resignation or death of the President, the Vice-President shall perform such duties as are the obligations of the President until the Commission elects a new President; and
