Resolution to Approve Street Closings for the UA Block Party and Plumbers & Pipefitters 5K - Monday, August 10, 2015

Attached for your consideration is a resolution to approve the closing of the following streets from 3:00 P.M. to 11:00 P.M. on Monday, August 10, 2015 to stage the UA (United Association) Block Party and the Plumbers & Pipefitters 5K:

- S. Main Street between William and Huron Streets
  - Liberty and Washington Streets between S. Ashley Street and S. Fourth Avenue

The actual event will take place from 6:00 P.M. until 10:00 P.M. with the additional time to be used for set-up and break-down of the event.

The Sponsor has requested the following streets be closed for the 5K from 6:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M.:

- Extend Liberty closure from S. Main Street to State Street
- State Street between North University and Washington
- North University northern/west bound lanes
- Washington Street southern/east bound lanes

The actual race will begin at 6:50 P.M. and end by 7:45 P.M. with the streets to open as soon as safely possible as the runners complete the course.

This event, sponsored by the Ann Arbor Area Convention and Visitors Bureau (AAACVB), is intended to attract people to the downtown area to enjoy the festivities. Classic and muscle cars will be the showcase of this event. Live entertainment will be provided from 6:00 P.M. and will conclude by 10:00 P.M.
