- WHEREAS, In Washtenaw County, and Ann Arbor in particular, there is a lack of affordable housing available due to the low vacancy, high rent market, which makes it difficult for those at risk of or experiencing homelessness to find stable, safe, and affordable housing; and
- WHEREAS, In 2017, over 5,000 people accessed homelessness services in Washtenaw County; and
- WHEREAS, In an effort to draw attention to the problems of hunger and homelessness, November 10 18, 2018 has been designated as National Hunger and Homelessness Awareness Week; and
- WHEREAS, The Shelter Association of Washtenaw County, in partnership with other organizations, is sponsoring events during this week that will highlight the struggles of those experiencing homelessness in our community; and
- WHEREAS, The City of Ann Arbor is committed to aiding the efforts of community partners to find lasting solutions to the problems of hunger and homelessness.
