The Ann Arbor Housing Commission's Housing Choice Voucher Administrative Plan details its policies and procedures for the management of its Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) Program. The AAHC periodically revises the Plan to reflect changes in HUD policies and changes in AAHC policies. WHEREAS, The Ann Arbor Housing Commission's Housing Choice Voucher Administrative Plan details its policies and procedures for the management of its Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) Program; and

WHEREAS, HUD requires the AAHC to adopt a preference and targeted funding for Non-Elderly Disabled Households as a condition of the NED vouchers awarded; and

WHEREAS, HUD requires the AAHC to adopt a preference and targeted funding for the Family Unification Program Vouchers awarded by HUD; and

WHEREAS, The waitlist policy related to preferences and special funding programs is confusing and needs clarification; and

RESOLVED, that the Board of the Ann Arbor Housing Commission approve the revisions to the Administrative Plan as described in the memorandum above to take effect on January 1, 2019.
