Resolution to Add an Additional Street Closure for the Monroe Street Fair on Saturday, April 6, 2019 The 2019 Monroe Street Fair was approved on February 19, 2019 at Enactment #R-19-064. Given the recent voter approved Proposal 1 regarding recreational marijuana, the applicant, Fred Heller/Creative Rec, LLC, has experienced multiple requests for additional booths and anticipates a larger crowd than ever before. The expanded footprint will alleviate congestion and allow for more diverse offerings.
