Resolution Authorizing Summary Publication of Ordinance No. 19-27 - An Ordinance to Amend Section 5.15 and 5.16.6.L of Chapter 55 (Unified Development Code) of Title V of the Code of the City of Ann Arbor (Office District Permitted Uses, Accessory Restaurant/Bar/Food Service Use Specific Standards)

RESOLVED, That the publication of Ordinance 19-27 shall be made by the following summary:

Ordinance No. 19-27 amends Section 5.15 (Table 5-15) and Section 5.16.6.L of Chapter 55 (Unified Development Code) of Title V of the Code of the City of Ann. The amendments allow for accessory restaurants, bar and food service use in the O district up to 10% of the total floor area of the site but not to exceed 12,000 square feet.

The effective date of the Ordinance is 10 days after publication.
