City of Ann Arbor Election Commission Resolution to Establish Absent Voter Counting Boards and Receiving Boards for the Presidential Primary Election to be Held in the City of Ann Arbor on Tuesday, March 10, 2020

Whereas, The City of Ann Arbor Election Commission was informed that a Presidential Primary Election will be held in the City of Ann Arbor on Tuesday, March 10, 2020 in all City wards; and

Whereas, The City Clerk's Office has determined that Absent Voter Count Boards will be needed for the tabulation of absentee ballots on March 10, 2020;

RESOLVED, That the Election Commission hereby authorizes the City Clerk to utilize up to ten Absent Voter Counting Boards for the tabulation of absentee ballots of the March 10, 2020 Presidential Primary Election; and

RESOLVED, That the Election Commission hereby authorizes the City Clerk to utilize up to twelve Receiving Boards at City Hall on Election Night to receive precinct returns as required under MCL 168.679a.
