Whereas, Section 12.2(b) of the City Charter states:

"Residency eligibility requirements for paid appointed officers shall be in accordance with State law. An unpaid appointive officer to a board or commission established pursuant to law, this charter or ordinance shall be eligible for appointment if he/she is a registered elector of this City, unless

this requirement is waived by a resolution in by not less than seven members of the Council."
