### Resolution to Approve Public Art Enhancement Recommendations for FY2023 - FY2028 Capital Improvement Projects

Chapter 24, Section 1:833 of City Code requires the Ann Arbor Public Art Commission to work with staff to make annual recommendations to City Council as to which projects from the current Capital Improvements Plan (CIP) are appropriate for designation as enhanced projects that will include public art, including the approximate amount of each project budget attributable to public art. City Council then approves the list of designated enhanced projects, with or without modification. City Council may modify the list at any time.

Note that the portion of the project budget attributable to public art included in this recommendation is intended to be guidance for staff in establishing and managing the proposed project budget. This resolution does not effect a budget amendment.

This resolution approves the Public Art Commission's recommendations as presented. Staff recommends approval.
