Whereas, Maple Village Homeowners Association, a Michigan nonprofit corporation, Mustafa Mehrabi, Jon Choate and Carol Choate, and Maple Cove of Ann Arbor, LLC, a Michigan limited liability company ("Grantors") are the interested parties in property commonly known Maple Village Condominium, Ann Arbor, Michigan 48103;

Whereas, Grantors have signed grants of easement for sanitary sewer and water main and appurtenances as illustrated and described on the attached maps; and

Whereas, Maple Village Homeowners Association and Mustafa Mehrabi have signed an easement agreement addressing a building encroachment in Unit 1 of the condominium;

RESOLVED, That the City of Ann Arbor hereby accepts these grants of easement and approves the easement agreement; and

RESOLVED, That the Mayor and City Clerk are authorized and directed to sign the easement agreement.
