## PROCLAMATION Huron River Day

July 17, 2011

WHEREAS, The Huron River is a major environmental asset of the Ann Arbor community; and

WHEREAS, All residents of the Ann Arbor area should know how important the river is to our community and how it is the responsibility of each of us, individually and jointly, to actively participate in its care and protection; and

WHEREAS, This is Ann Arbor's 31st<sup>h</sup> celebration of Huron River Day; and the first to be joined by parks throughout the length of the river; and
