Resolution to Approve the Skelley Annexation, 0.3 Acre, 545 Allison Drive (CPC Recommendation: Approval - 8 Yeas and 0 Nays)

Approval of this resolution will allow annexation of this property from Scio Township into the City. The property is within the City's water and sewer service area, and the current use is consistent with the adjacent zoning, land uses and master plan. Council action on the proposed R1C (Single-Family Dwelling District) zoning will be scheduled after the annexation process is complete.

The City Planning Commission, at its meeting of August 16, 2011, recommended approval of the request.
