Huron River Day Proclamation

PROCLAMATION Huron River Day July 15, 2012

WHEREAS, The Huron River is a major environmental asset of the Ann Arbor community; and

- WHEREAS, This is Ann Arbor's 32nd celebration of Huron River Day; and
- WHEREAS, This is a day for residents of the Ann Arbor Community to enjoy being on the river and its shores with games, exhibits, walks, canoes and paddle boats and to learn more about its care.
