Resolution to Approve the 1427 Warrington Circle Annexation, 1.26 Acres, South Side of S. Warrington Drive, East of Newport Road (CPC Recommendation: Approval - 7 Yeas and 0 Nays) Approval of this resolution will allow annexation of this property from Ann Arbor Township into the City. The property is within the City's water and sewer service area, and the current use is consistent with the adjacent zoning, land uses and master plan. Council action on the proposed R1A (Single Family District) zoning will be scheduled after the annexation process is complete.

The City Planning Commission, at its meeting of July 5, 2017, recommended approval of the request.
