CTN 35th Anniversary Proclamation

***PROCLAMATION***  
***Recognizing Community Television Network's 35<sup>th</sup> Anniversary***  
***September 5th, 2008***

- WHEREAS, The City of Ann Arbor has long believed in and promoted the concept of community access television, and was one of the first cities in the country to create an organization to provide this service; and*
- WHEREAS, In 1973 Community Television network began providing a variety of media services to allow residents, non-profit organizations, service clubs, educational institutions, government agencies, and elected officials to speak directly to the Ann Arbor community through the powerful medium of cable television; and*
- WHEREAS, Now, 35 years later, Ann Arbor's Community Television Network has grown to four channels (16,17,18, and 19 on Comcast Cable), providing Ann Arbor government and education meetings, original programs and public access to homes across the greater Ann Arbor area; and*
- WHEREAS, Community Television Network is holding a public celebration on September 5, 2008, from 3-7p.m. to mark it's 35<sup>th</sup> Anniversary and facility grand opening at 2805 S. Industrial Highway, suite 200, in Ann Arbor; and*
- WHEREAS, The City of Ann Arbor commends Community Television Network's staff, Cable Communications Commission, volunteers and community groups who have made this achievement possible.*
